Must be a rectangle 8 in. wide x 9 in. high

Theme: "The Winter that Never Ended"

Any construction method, hand or machine quilted by entrant. Quilt backing must include a centered, vertical sleeve in which a paint stick has been inserted. The paint stick must be included and ready for display.

Class 1 Youth entry under 18 years of age

Class 2 Open – any age

Class 3 Senior Citizen 65 years of age and over
